With only three years of experience as an NHD teacher, Hendrix sets high expectations for her students by providing a rigorous learning environment through technological integration and a focus on character development. She concentrates on instilling skills such as research, synthesis and analysis, fostering creativity and higher-order thinking to help her students succeed beyond the classroom. "The honor of representing Georgia as the National History Day program Teacher of the Year means that I may personally attest to the correlation between educational rigor and student success," stated Hendrix. "When each student experiences success in my classroom after mastery of rigorous content or skills, they realize they can apply the steps necessary for success in other venues as well." The Patricia Behring Teacher of the Year Award recognizes outstanding National History Day teachers. Two teachers, one each at the junior and senior level, are selected from each of the 50 states, the District of Columbia, Department of Defense Schools, International Schools-Asia and U.S. territories. National History Day is a highly-regarded academic program for elementary and secondary school students.
