Student Learning Objectives (S.L.O.s)

LEA developed SLOs are content-specific, grade level learning objectives that are measurable, focused on growth in student learning, and aligned to curriculum standards. As a measure of teachers' impact on student learning, SLOs give educators, school systems, and state leaders an additional means by which to understand, value, and recognize success in the classroom. The primary purpose of SLOs is to improve student learning at the classroom level. An equally important purpose of SLOs is to provide evidence of each teacher's instructional impact on student learning. SLOs will be administered by teachers of non-tested subjects with the exception of third grade content area teachers who will give a SLO and EOG Georgia Milestones Test.
